

Documentation of Community Notice of Intent to Apply

This notice is to announce that Waianae High School is applying for the 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC) grant. If approved, the 21st CCLC program will provide students and their families with academic enrichment opportunities and support services to help meet state and local standards in core content areas.

Our proposed after-school program will include free after-school enrichment, physical well-being, social-emotional, and culturally relevant learning activities, and academic support. Academic supports include homework help, math and reading intervention and tutorials, and credit recovery options. Enrichment and physical well-being activities include curriculum-based clubs or competitive teams formed around academic subjects. Students will also be provided with opportunities for community services with adult mentorship.

Should the need arise, we will provide virtual/online programs for students. We will offer opportunities for families and students to engage in family-focused events that showcase student work and performances and provide other educational opportunities for families.
